

Coastal Erosion & Coastal Development



Coastal erosion will affect your property if you build too close to the shoreline.

Construction, clearing vegetation, land reclamation and coastal defenses at the shoreline can all cause an increase in the rate of coastal erosion

Help prevent erosion and protect your family by building any new property land-ward of the circumferential road or a minimum of 100 feet from the vegetation line at the shoreline.
